POPE FRANCIS

Pope Francis, was the first pope from Argentina. He significantly impacted the Catholic Church and global society through his focus on compassion, social justice, and environmental stewardship. Emphasising a pastoral approach, he has sought to engage with marginalised communities and promote dialogue among diverse faiths. Pope Francis has been a vocal advocate for the poor, often highlighting issues related to economic inequality and urging systemic change to address poverty. His encyclical "Laudato Si" calls for urgent action against climate change and emphasises humanity's responsibility to care for the earth. Additionally, he has championed reform within the Church, addressing. issues of clerical abuse and promoting a greater role for women in church life. Through his warm demeanor and commitment to humility, Pope Francis inspired many around the world to live out the principles of love and solidarity.

School for Seniors are hosting a morning tea with all proceeds going to cancer research, come along there will be lucky door prizes and or course morning tea.


